Christmas- Children will know the main features of the Christmas Story and will understand some of the difficulties faced by the different characters in the story. The children will ask deeper questions about the actions of Herod and why he was so opposed to the birth of this special child.

Parable and Sayings of Jesus- The children will be able to recall some of Jesus' teaching in the Parables and know that they contain some messages about living as followers of Christ today. The children will understand the Kingdom of God was part of the language Jesus used to explain his preaching about welcoming and accepting God's presence through him.

For World Religion fortnight, Year 5 will learn about Sikhism.

Homework

Maths

Multiplication and division- Children multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one- or two-digit number using a formal written method, including long multiplication for two-digit numbers. Also, children will learn to divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one-digit number using the formal written method of short division and interpret remainders appropriately for the context. Please ensure your child is fluent in times tables and division facts (up to and including x12).

Fractions- Children will develop their knowledge of fractions by finding equivalent fractions. To be able to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number. To recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other and write mathematical statements > 1 as a mixed number [for example, $2/5 + 4/5 = 6/5 = 1 \ 1/5$]. To read, write, order and compare numbers with up to three decimal places.
