<u>English</u> §

In the Spring Term Year 2 will be studying fantasy fiction. We will write our own version of the Paper Bag Princess by Robert Munsch.

We will also be looking at persuasion and poetry, studying a poem called Bedtime by Eleanor Farjeon. We will be writing our own persuasive letters.

We will look at more po<u>etry -</u> It's Behind You! Monster Poems by Paul Cookson and David Harmer. We will write our own poems based on this genre. We will study historical Fiction -

The Baker's Boy and the Great Fire of London -Tom Bradman. We will write diary entries and a biography

We will be looking at Living things and their habitats Children learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there. We will then study Animals including Humans - Diet and health

Focusing their own experiences, children explore the need for humans to eat a varied diet, to keep themselves clean, and to take regular

<u>Year 2</u> Spring Term 2022

Maths

This term we will studying multiplication and division looking at making equal groups, dividing by 2, 5 and 10 and using our times table facts to work out problems. We will study statistics - tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams. We will look at properties of shapes and fractions. This will include recognizing and finding halves an quarters.

Religious Education

We have been learning about Christmas and special celebrations this term, including Baptism. We will be learning all about Lent and Holy week too. We continue to learn our class prayers and read confidently from the scripture.

This term we will be learning about being safe on line. We are alson focussing on presentation

Children focus on important computer skills needed for safe and effective computer use and introduce some further skills concerning the use of folders, searching for files and printing. Children are introduced to presentations and teach the skills needed to create a simple resentation.

In PE this term Year 2 will study gymnastics and ball skills. Children will repeat a sequence of gymnastic moves incorporating smooth transitions. We will be learning key tennis skills - holding the racket correctly and ball control.
