English:

Throughout the term Reception class will be sharing a number of texts that fall within our topic questions of 'Who will we meet?' And 'Where will we go?'

We will continue to work and build on children's ability to construct and write words and sentences completing a number of written pieces in a variety of writing genres.

Children will take part in daily phonics lessons to support their word segmenting and blending allowing them to build fluency in reading

Religious Education:

This term we will begin by looking at the creation story and how God created the world. Children will develop their understanding of creation including learning about gifts and talents that God has given. To know that the Bible is God's book. We will be looking at all of our gospel virtues; Eloquent and truthful and how we can live life as followers of Jesus.

Expressive art and

This term we will be exploring being imaginative and creative we will cover a wide variety of themes that / link to stories shared in class including Little Red Riding Hood, The Gruffalo and the Paddington Bear Stories.

Understanding the World: Science

This term children will be looking closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change. Children will carry out observations of their local environment and the world around them. Sketching and taking part in small experiments in the classroom.

Computing

Throughout the term children will be giving the opportunity to develop their computer skills using school iPads and chrome books. They will also be introduced to the learning platform Purple mash.

This term children will develop their fundamental movement skills through the topic of 'all about me', including balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and travelling. Children will develop gross motor skills through a range of activities. They will learn how to stay safe using space, working independently and with a partner. They will also have an introduction to dance, building skills in counting keeping in time with music and performing to their peers.
