#### Procedures for contacting school

During busy school life, there will be times when you wish to have a discussion with school about your child or raise an issue/concern with us. If you wish to discuss your child, their progress or a friendship issue, your first point of contact should be their class teacher who can be contacted over the phone or via the enquiry@ email. If the issue persists, it is at this point that you should contact Mrs Noble-Barton for further discussion and action. Following on, if things still aren't resolved, this would be where Mr Porter becomes involved. This clear chain means that issues can be dealt with efficiently by the most appropriate member of staff.

Please do not hesitate to speak to school if you have any queries or concerns; this is far more constructive than discussing it at the school gate or on Whatsapp without involving school in the conversation.
