

Lord Jesus, come to me.


Lord Jesus, give me your love.

- I. The sign of the cross.

We may both imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, Through the same Christ our Lord.



The Stations of the Cross

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death.
- 2. Jesus receives the cross.
- 3. Jesus falls for the first time.
- 4. Jesus meets his mother.
- 5. Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus to carry the cross.
- 6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus.
- 7. Jesus falls for the second time.
- 8. Jesus speaks to the woman.
- 9. Jesus falls for the third time.
- 10. Jesus is stripped of his garments.
- II. Jesus is nailed to the cross.
- 12. Jesus dies on the cross.
- 13. Jesus is taken down from the cross.
- 14. Jesus is laid in the tomb.



At each station, think about the suffering of Jesus. Then say; one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory be to the Father, followed by this prayer;

O Jesus, who for love of me did bear your cross to Calvary, in thy sweet mercy grant to me, to suffer and to die with thee, I love you, Jesus my love, above all things, I repent with my whole heart of having offended you, never permit me to separate myself from you again.

Grant that I may love you always, and then do with me what you will.

The Angelus

Leader: The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

Response: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

All: Hail Mary...

Leader: Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

Response: Be it done unto me according to thy word.

All: Hail Mary...

Leader: And the Word was made flesh.

Response: And dwelt among us.

All: Hail Mary...

Leader: Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

Response: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

All: Lord, fill our hearts with your love,

and as you revealed to us by an angel,

the coming of your Son as man,

so lead us through his suffering and death,

to the Glory of His Resurrection,

for he lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit,

one God, forever and ever.

My soul glorifies the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God, my Saviour, he looks on his servant in her lowliness, henceforth all ages will call me blessed.


The Almighty works marvels for me, Holy is His name!
