

English:

In Year 1 we would like the children to continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly. They will also learn how to join sentences with 'and' or 'because'.

We will be looking at different books and texts to help us with our writing such as: 'Knuffle Bunny', 'Five minutes' peace', 'Oi Frog', 'Oi Dog', 'My name is' and 'The Usbourne Big book of machines'. We will create our own stories where we can apply all of our knowledge to longer pieces of writing. We will be looking at information texts about significant figures.



Science:



We will be Identifying and naming a variety of objects and materials. The children will also look at what plants need to survive. We will plant our own seed and observe how it grows. We will also look at Seasonal changes in Autumn and Winter.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning to count forwards, backwards and write numbers to 20.

We will also be looking at:

Number- addition and subtraction within 20.

Place value- understanding number to 50. Counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Measurement- length and height.

Also the children need to continue to write and form numbers correctly by ensuring they are the right way round.

In RE this term we will begin by learning about Creation. Then we will look at Families and Celebrations.
