






## Year 6 Blackwell Residential Parents' Meeting

	Shorts (in the summer months)
	Underclothes
	Socks
	Hike boots/strong shoes and or Wellingtons
	Training shoes
	Slippers/Indoor shoes (Outside shoes are not permitted in the Manor House)
	Swimwear
	Waterproof (and over trousers if owned - not essential)

✓ T	ick once packed
	Wool hat, scarf, and gloves or Sun hat and sun cream
	Wash kit
	Towel
	Torch and spare batteries
	Water bottle
	Bin Bag - for wet and or dirty washing
	Spending money (ideally in coins please)
	Pen and Paper
	Medication (if required i.e. asthma inhalers)
	Sleeping bag (if linen is not provided as part of the booking)
	Pillow (If in tented village or Stable Block)

#### Safeguarding and Risk Assessment

The trip is fully risk assessed by St. Nicholas School. Each activity is fully RA by Blackwell.

Blackwell staff are DBS checked.

St. Nicholas staff are first aid trained.

Risks are identified and measures put in place to mitigate risk.

Staff members attending are briefed by trip leader before the trip.

Trip leader is in regular contact with school staff both in and out of school hours.

Children are not permitted to bring their mobile phones. Staff will communicate with parents where necessary.
